Lenten Regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast. On fast days, one full meal and two lesser meals are allowed. Eating between meals is not permitted. Catholics who have completed their 18th year are bound by this law until the beginning of their 60th year. **Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent also are days of abstinence.** On days of abstinence, meat may not be taken. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics who have completed their 14th year. If members of the faithful are unable to observe these regulations because of ill health or other reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of penance and self-denial suitable to their condition.
